Document Advisor, Inc – Software Developer Apr. 2019 – Present

- As a member of a 12 person developer team my responsibilities include: peer reviewing merge requests, fixing bugs, coding new features, participating in pair programming sessions, and communicating with our Product team to develop story ideas and ensure technical feasibility.
- The company is 100% remote, and we work in an asynchronous fashion. We don't depend on instant answers to questions to be productive. Most days we're juggling multiple tasks and we use tools like: ClickUp, Sentry, Slack and Signal to communicate and stay organized.
- The main project we work on is a CMS built with Laravel and Vue.js. The site, ivisa.com, is a way to help travelers apply for any necessary documents (visas, health declarations, embassy registrations, etc). There's a customer facing side for researching travel destinations and placing orders, and an admin dashboard where agents process orders, manage products and prices, maintain blog entries and more.

- Developed and deployed an online enrollment system for a program geared towards homeschooled children. An API was built and designed in Laravel and a front end SPA was built in Vue.js. We worked closely with school officials to coordinate training and design a strong user experience.
- Helped maintain and troubleshoot the main district website, www.mpsaz.org. This was a custom PHP CMS that was built in 2010. Most work involved bug fixes and code refactoring.
- Communicated regularly with our IT Department to make sure web servers and database servers were up and running at all times.
